By the mid-1950's Glen's built a new store ext door; and added on in the early 60's to eate a floor space of 11,000 square feet. Glen's joined Spartan Stores in 1952, and tablished new Glen's Markets at alkaska in 1956 and Grayling in 1959. Since en, new Glen's Markets have been started

In 1967, the Glen's Market in Gaylord oved to what was then an empty field near

the Interstate 75 interchange with M-32 and built a 22,000 square foot store. An 11,000 square foot addition was completed in 1972.

Today, the chain is still headquartered in Gaylord, with C. Glen Catt serving as president of Glen's Markets, Inc. Keith Catt, his brother, is senior vice-president, while Glen A. Catt, C. Glen's son, is vice-president of retail operations.

Other administrators for the chain include Del Lewis and Denny Freeman, supervisors for the 11 stores; Dale Domsten, director of general merchandise; Bert Taylor, director of meat: Art Kramer, director of produce; Vern Kavitch, director of advertising and promotions; Bill Brown, personnel director; Gale Parker, superintendent of construction maintenance and equipment.

Glen's Market is a family center offering a wide range of goods and products besides

Unique to Glen's is the store's "Save-Share Program." Since its inception in 1972, Glen's has returned an estimated \$750,000 into local community projects. The program allows non-profit community groups to raise money for worthy projects by saving Glen's cash register receipts
