Harmonie Meisters

Since 1995, the Harmonie Meisters have been sharing their gift and love of music with the residents of Northern Michigan. Gary Grieger, VP for Public Relations notes: "Our biggest show is the Bush League Competition in August. This is a Barbershop quartet competition that got it's start in 1947 in Boyne City. The Harmonie Meisters took over sponsorship of the competition in 1995".

This is an all day event where newly formed barbershop quartets from around Michigan, who have never won anytime in a competition, are invited to compete for the top three sports. The winner is given a trophy that has passed each year since 1947, the coveted Brass Gaboon, a spittoon from the hotel lobby where the first competition was held.

The competition will take place on Saturday, August 24th at the E Free Church in Gaylord. The competing quartets will take turns singing in the morning and will be judged and coached throughout the day. The top three quartets will perform in the evening at the "Show of Champions" along with last year's winners, the "Classic Fit", the Harmonie Meisters of Gaylord, and 2012 State Champions "Majestix". This will be a great show for anyone who loves Barbershop Quartets, one of the five original art form started in the USA.
