GAYLORD ST. MARY MOCK TRIAL TEAM WINS STATE FINALS IN LANSING

The Gaylord St. Mary High School mock trial team recently won the State Championship at the annual "Youth in Government Conference" MJP State Final Competition.

The 'Model Judiciary Program' (MJP) is a part of the YMCA's long-standing 'Youth in Government Program'.

Teams of high school students from across the State of Michigan compete each year against one another during the 4 day conference as part of the mock trial program. The students, four per team, take on alternating roles as attorneys and witness in presenting a hypothetical case to volunteer judges over the course of the YIG Conference. The competition stresses proper courtroom demeanor and good conduct, along with basic knowledge of the law and trial procedures.

The St. Mary High School MJP Team of Kaitlin Broz, Michelle Samalik, Patrick O'Connor, and Luke Wisniewski won the State Championship title after the 9th and final round of the MJP Competition last Saturday.

During the months leading up to the annual conference, the students work with volunteer coaches from the legal community and school advisor Diane Purgiel. Kiwanian and Gaylord attorney Robert Westerman and Circuit Judge Dennis Murphy helped the students practice their case, teaching proper courtroom demeanor as well as trial basics.

This is the second consecutive year the St Mary MJP team took top honors at the competition. The coaches noted that this was an incredible accomplishment for this St. Mary team, and win or lose; the annual conference is a great learning experience for all the students that participated from across Michigan.
